The bold symbols indicate the location of Information Boards around the estate.

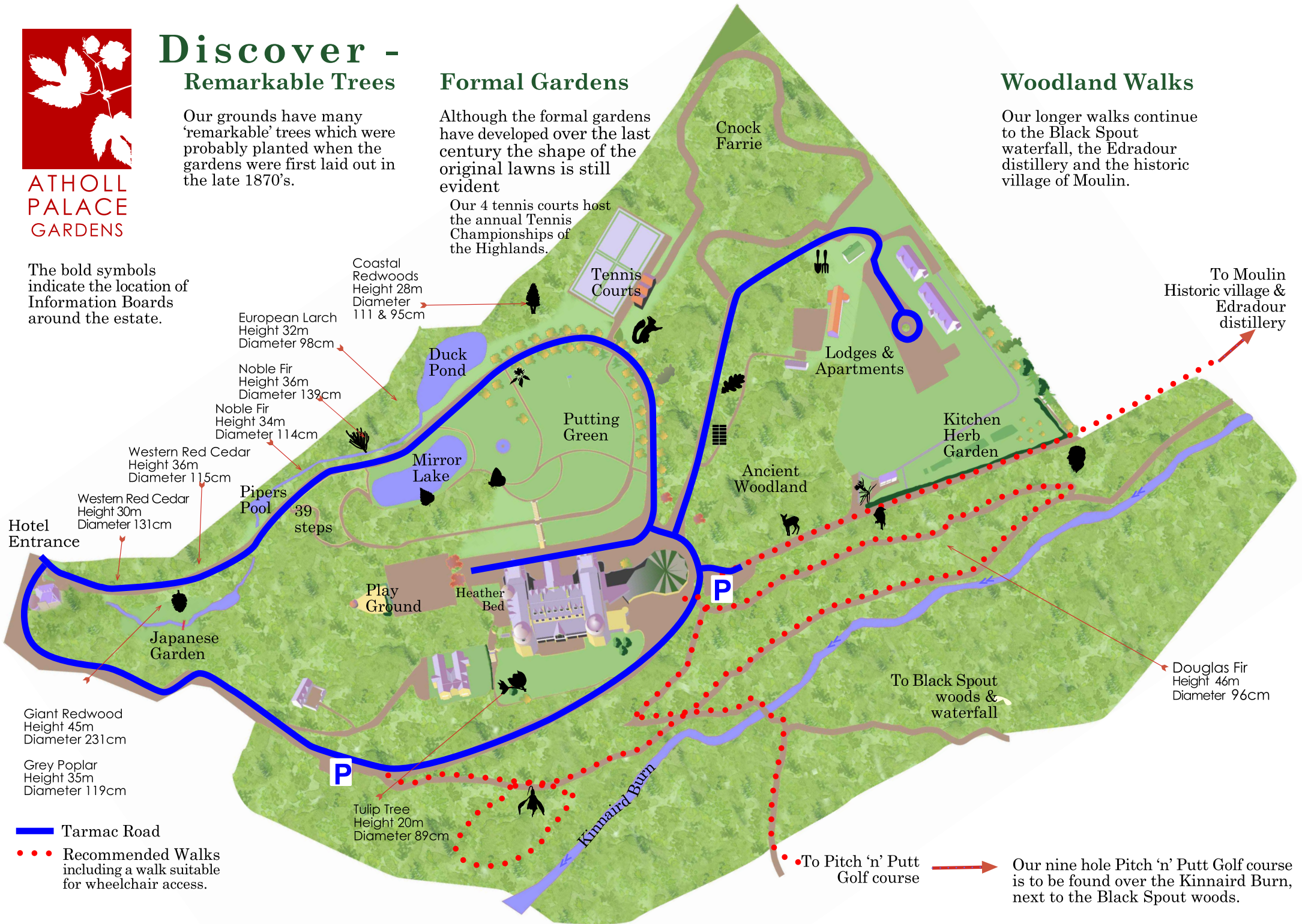
Formal Gardens
