- 1 Duval-Leroy Brut £45.50
- 90 Duval-Leroy Brut Mini 20cl £19.95  
125ml £7.95  
*France* - A fresh, modern style and the only Champagne selected by the Wine Spectator in its "100 Most Exciting Wines of 2008".
- 2 Taittinger Prestige Brut Rosé £67.95  
*France* - Stylish and dry with delicious summer fruit aromas and a long, full-bodied flavour typical of Pinot Noir based Champagnes.
- 3 Taittinger Brut Réserve £66.50  
*France* - Perhaps the lightest and most elegant of the Grand Marque Champagnes, an intensely fragrant character, subtle biscuity complexity and superb elegance from a predominance of Chardonnay.
- 4 Dom Pérignon Brut £205.95  
*France* - Long and satisfying on the palate with layers of yeasty, nutty flavours, superbly fat and ripe. Complex, luxury Grand Cru Champagne made only in the best years.
- 5 Codorníu Brut, Cava £21.95  
125ml £4.75  
*Italy* - Classy, dry, sparkling wine, this renowned house choose to use the traditional Spanish varieties of Parellada, Xarel-lo and Macabeo.
- 7 Prosecco Extra Dry, Fantinel, Friuli-Venezia-Gulia £28.50  
125ml £5.25  
*Italy* - Fresh, dry and fruity. A pleasant and extremely elegant bouquet with delightful, floral-based hints. A smooth, velvety and poetic flavour.
- 8 Fantinel 'One & Only' Single Vineyard Prosecco Brut £29.95  
*Italy* - It has a vibrant nose, with floral notes against a background of ripe fruit and brioche; the elegant palate shows ripe apple and pear fruit flavours.

## Very dry, delicate, light white

- 11 Vinuva Trebbiano Rubicone £18.50

*Italy* - Refreshingly dry with zesty notes of apple and citrus fruit.
- 12 Organic Pinot Grigio Pavia, Vinuva £21.75

*Italy* - Light, delicately flavoured, refreshingly dry with hints of apple.
- 15 Don Jacobo Rioja Blanco, Bodegas Corral, Rioja £23.25  
*Spain* - Fresh, dry, crisp and modern, from this classic Spanish region using the local Viura grape.
- 21 Gavi di Gavi La Toledana, Domini Villa Lanata, Piemonte £33.95  
*Italy* - This excellent producer crafts this refreshing gooseberry and mineral style with delicate floral hints, dry but not austere.
- 22 Chablis Gloire de Chablis, J. Moreau et Fils, Chablis £38.50  
*France* - A traditional Chablis, dry, flinty and elegant with distinctive Chardonnay character on the finish.

## Dry, herbaceous or aromatic white

- 14 Luis Felipe Edwards Reserva Gewürztraminer, Rapel Valley £21.95  
*Chile* - Perfect topography produces a classic example of this aromatic grape; big flavours of lychees, apricots, honey and warm spice.
- 16 Touraine Sauvignon, Domaine Trotignon, Touraine £27.25  
*France* - Deliciously prominent gooseberry fruit flavours and an appealing freshness. This wine has a long finish and is an excellent example of Loire Sauvignon Blanc.
- 19 Drylands Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough £32.50  
*New Zealand* - Ripe, rich herbal and tropical fruit flavours combine in a vibrant burst of flavour on the palate.
- 23 Flagstone Noon Gun Chenin Blanc-Sauvignon Blanc-Viognier, Western Cape £22.50  
£7.60

*South Africa* - Intense, aromatic, tropical fruit flavours spiked with a wedge of orange peel and a sprinkling of baking spice.
- 24 Sancerre, La Gravelière, Joseph Mellot, Central Vineyards £37.50  
*France* - Vibrant, aromatic Sauvignon Blanc at its best, opulent on the nose and palate, stylishly dry on the finish.
- 27 Waipara Hills Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough £27.25  
*New Zealand* - A generous and lifted style, showing powerful aromas of melon, nettle and snow pea; the palate bursts with fresh citrus, grapefruit and melon notes, the fruit carrying through to the aromatic finish.
- 29 Luis Felipe Edwards Lot 66 Sauvignon Blanc, Rapel Valley £23.50

*Chile* - Hand harvested, gently pressed to retain the natural fruit aromas and flavour of citrus fruit, melon, pineapple and pear.

## Juicy, fruit-driven ripe white

- 13 The Gourmet Chardonnay £19.50

*Australia* - Fruit-driven Chardonnay, unoaked with zesty, citrusy fruit and a structure for food.
- 18 Drylands Dry Riesling, Marlborough £33.25  
*New Zealand* - Aromas of flora and citrus fruits accompanied by lively grapefruit, lime and honeysuckle.
- 20 Anavia Verdejo Pagos del Rey, Rueda £26.50  
*Spain* - Complex aromas of ripe white peach, pear and lemon with floral hints, an unctuous palate with white fruit and mineral notes.
- 25 Pouilly-Fuissé Les Ancolies, E. Loron et Fils £43.95  
*France* - A steely, dry yet rich white Burgundy from this most prestigious of the Mâconnais vineyards. It is a Chardonnay that combines honeyed peachy richness with a citrus freshness.

## Full-flavoured, nutty, oaked white

- 17 Côtes du Rhône, Les Abeilles Blanc, Jean-Luc Colombo £27.50  
*France* - Fine and intense floral aromas, notes of fresh fruits and candied lemon. Nicely rounded and fresh; surprises with its complexity and lively structure.
- 26 Over the Shoulder Chardonnay, Yarra Valley £41.50  
*Australia* - The palate is lithe, fresh and racy; mineral, wet stone, citrus flowers and grapefruit. It is long and linear in shape, with a juicy, mouth-watering natural acidity.

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## Dry, elegant rosé

- 50 Côtes du Rhône Rosé, Les Rabassières, Southern Rhône £25.25  
*France* - Lovely combination of Grenache and Syrah makes a vibrant dry fresh classic southern French wine.
- 53 Pinot Grigio Rosato del Veneto, Collezione Marchesin £23.75  
£7.95  
£5.95  
*Italy* - Dry and subtly flavoured raspberry and apple-scented rosé from the north-east of Italy.

## Rich, fruity rosé

- 51 Berri Estates Rosé, South-Eastern Australia £19.25  
*Australia* - Strawberry, plum and redcurrant flavours with a soft, not too dry, finish.
- 52 Vendange White Zinfandel, California £22.50  
£7.60

*USA* - A brief time with juice and skin together gives this delicate colour, delicious strawberry aroma and zingy freshness.

## Light, simple, delicate red

- 60 Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Collezione Marchesin £18.50

*Italy* - Grown on the eastern Adriatic coastline giving an intensity of colour and heady bouquet of violets and oranges.

## Juicy, medium-bodied, fruit-led red

- 61 Los Romeros Merlot, Central Valle £19.50  
*Chile* - Soft, warm and smooth red with lots of blackcurrant and plum fruits and a dash of spice.
- 62 Callia Cabernet Sauvignon, San Juan £22.50  
*Argentina* - Blackberry and blackcurrant fruit shows on the palate with a lovely, soft and gently spiced finish.
- 63 Château Haut Roudier, Bordeaux £23.75  
*France* - Deep cherry red with coulis-style berry fruit, youthful cherry vibrancy and a rich concentration displaying a delicious freshness.
- 64 Cape 1652 Pinotage, Western Cape £24.50  
*South Africa* - Smooth, soft and rich blackcurrant with a nice splattering of spice on the juicy finish.
- 65 Syrah Lazio Siroe, Fontana Candida, Lazio £26.25  
*Italy* - Well structured, showing Syrah's hedgerow fruit character ahead of a smooth finish.
- 68 Don Jacobo Rioja Crianza Tinto, Bodegas Corral, Rioja £28.50  
*Spain* - Abundant bright raspberry aromas mingle with sumptuous cherries and layered with a creamy barrique character.

## Spicy, peppery, warming red

- 66 Portillo Malbec, Valle de Uco, Mendoza £26.95  
*Argentina* - Plums, blackberries and a touch of vanilla; fresh fruit flavours, supported by a touch of spice.
- 67 Côtes du Rhône, Les Abeilles Rouge, Jean-Luc Colombo £27.50  
*France* - Fresh and silky on the palate, the aromas of small red fruits follow through, prolonged by notes of liquorice and spice.
- 77 La Campagne Syrah, Pays d'Oc £19.75  
£6.60  
£5.00  
*France* - The Syrah grape thrives in the sunny Languedoc region and produces a rich, juicy wine with soft tannins and a spicy palate.
- 86 The Gourmet Shiraz, South Australia £18.50

*Australia* - Restrained blackberry fruit backed by a crisp finish..

## Oaked, intense, concentrated red

- 70 Durbanville Hills Bastion Cabernet Sauvignon-Shiraz £30.50  
*South Africa* - A full-bodied wine with notes of berries, prunes and spice; a soft and velvety mouth-feel and a lingering fruity finish.
- 71 Bethany g6 Shiraz, Barossa Valley £35.95  
*Australia* - The aroma is generous and the mouth-feel elegant yet full flavoured, whilst the lingering finish is a delightful blend of blackberry fruit and restrained oak spice.
- 72 Nobilo Icon Pinot Noir, Marlborough £40.50  
*New Zealand* - Rich, concentrated with some new oak flavours backing up vibrant cherry and smooth plum fruit.
- 73 Barolo Enrico Serafino £47.95  
*Italy* - Big, well-structured red, intensely elegant nose, with red fruit and spicy notes of liquorice and vanilla.
- 76 Merlot Vin de France, J Moreau et Fils £22.75  
£7.60

*France* - Soft and juicy with ripe berry fruit.
- 74 Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Les Cornalines £35.00  
*France* - Traditions ensure heady aromas of spices and a long velvet character laden with warm fruit cake flavours.

*Spain* - Moscatel de Alejandria and Moscatel de Grano Menudo used to produce this sweet luscious wine, the perfect accompaniment to any dessert. 125ml £5.95
