| This delightful bottle-fermented rosé wine which is made from 90% Cabernet Franc and 10% Grolleau, has an uplifting palate of crushed berries.   |              |                |
| <b>3. Henriot Brut Souverain N</b>   |              | <b>£67.00</b>  |
| On nose of white flower and citrus fruit notes, then with a balanced, harmonious palate. Brut Souverain is made up of a balanced proportion of Chardonnay, the majority from the Côte des Blancs, and Pinot Noir, mostly from the Montagne de Reims. Pinot Meunier adds a delicate fruitiness note.                            |              |                |
| <b>4. Rosé Brut, Rathfinny Wine Estate, Southern England</b>   |              | <b>£72.00</b>  |
| Pale coral hue and a vibrant nose with aromas of cranberry, cherry blossom and red apple. The palate is lively with concentrated notes of pink grapefruit and brioche. Juicy acidity and silky texture punctuate the wine's refreshing finish.   |              |                |
| <b>5. NV Brut Réserve, Charles Heidsieck, Champagne</b>  |              | <b>£85.00</b>  |
| The nose shows an abundance of floral and fruity aromas like white peach, fresh apricot and mirabelle plum, highlighted with a touch of jasmine and honeysuckle. The palate is a complex combination of saline character and silky texture evoking flavours of nougat and buttery cream.                                       |              |                |

| It is expressive with fragrant peach, white flower and vanilla notes beautifully balanced with honey and baked biscuit.  |              |                |

| It's an elegant, soft pink with a delicate bubble. The initial nose is saline and mineral, underlined by hints of toast and smoke, but soon opens to express luxurious notes of pink grapefruit, blood orange, redcurrants and Morello cherries. The palate is creamy and complex, with notes of liquorice and blackberry tea. |              |                |

- 10. Chardonnay, Chablis 1er Cru Domaine Roy, Burgundy, France** £67.00  
Intense fruit but with the underlying minerality that makes them fresh and vibrant.
- 11. 'Voski', Zorah, Vayots Dzor, Armenia** £67.00  
Generous aromas of pear, peach and apricot, with subtle nutty hints. It has a rich texture and a beautiful freshness on the palate, supported by a soft minerality.
- 12. Esprit de Tablas Blanc, Tablas Creek, California, USA** £85.00  
Rich, and flavors of honey and spice, while Grenache Blanc adds green apple and anise flavors, a lush mouthfeel and bright acids. Picpoul Blanc adds pineapple brightness and saline minerality while Picardan brings elegance.
- 13. Chardonnay, Sylvain Bzikot, Meursault, Burgundy, France** £90.00  
Full-bodied, fruity and spice with notes of vanilla, peaches and almond.
- 14. Chardonnay, 'Lé Trézin', Domaine Larue, Puligny-Montrachet, France** £120.00  
Beautiful aromas of vanilla, citrus, melon and brioche on the nose. Outstanding notes derived from oak, very buttery and toasty with high acidity, medium body and long finish.

Intense notes of red apple, red grape and strawberry compliment is vibrant acidity and long finish.
- 2. Grenache, Rosé Tendem, Bruno Andreu, Languedoc, France** £7.50 £10.00 £29.00  
It is fresh and light and perfect as an early summer sundowner. It's bursting with fresh summer red summer fruit flavours of strawberry, raspberry and cranberry.
- 3. Côtes de Provence Rosé, Miraval, France** £47.00  
This is a fresh, elegant rosé, with flavours of redcurrant and citrus, mineral and saline notes and a long, intense finish.

# RED WINE

- 10. Cabernet Sauvignon, Meerlust Rubicon, Stellenbosch, South Africa** **£68.00**

On the nose with violets, ripe plum, cedar wood and intense spiciness. A typical liquorice note also evident on the nose. Still young and intense, promising further maturation potential. The palate is full bodied, structured but packed with fresh dark fruit and rounded, linear tannin.
- 11. Château Musar, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon** **£79.00**

Red cherries, plums and figs dominate the nose with a hint of eastern spice. Kirsch and plums follow through to the palate with blackcurrant and chocolate. The tannins are velvety soft and has a lot of depth and fruit concentration with a long finish.
- 12. Château Moulin Haut-Laroque, Bordeaux, France** **£90.00**

The wine has ripe tannins and a silky texture which is complemented by tobacco and leather aromas.
- 13. Châteauneuf-du-Pape, 'Les Sinards', Famille Perrin 'Les Crus', Rhône, France** **£92.00**

It's a deep, smooth red that's packed with raspberries, cherries, blackberries, blueberries, cinnamon and spice.
- 14. Corvina, Amarone della Valpolicella, Reserva, Marchesi Fumanelli, Veneto, Italy** **£95.00**

An intense and perfumed wine with ripe red berry fruit, sweet vanilla notes, nutmeg, spice and chocolate.
- 15. Tempranillo, Lopez de Heredia, Viña Tondonia Reserva, Rioja, Spain** **£99.00**

Aromas of sweet strawberries and raspberries mingle with that classic fresh leather note, so typical of this wine. Autumn leaves and wild sage appear but underneath all these classic tertiary aromas lies a concentrated ball of fruit.
- 16. Nebbiolo, Barolo, Damilano "Lecinquevigne", Italy** **£125.00**

It is fresh, approachable, aromatic and displays wonderful fresh red fruit, spice, leather and floral notes.
